## 1. Blueball Qubit Designs Information and Tips

### How to install your Blueball Qubit designs:

After you download your Blueball Qubit designs bundle file you will need to double click on it to unzip the file. In the Blueball\_ Qubit\_v3\_SV2 folder you will find 12 individual Blueball Qubit Sandvox 2 design files that end with the extension .svxDesign. **To install each Blueball Qubit design you need to double click on each design file, and the design will be automatically installed into Sandvox 2. By default all third party designs are installed into Sandvox's Application Support folder. After you finish installing your designs, you MUST restart Sandvox 2 before your newly installed designs will appear in the design preview window in the Sandvox 2 work window.**

### Your Blueball Qubit v3 designs bundle includes:

- 12 Blueball Qubit designs, all with one wide page width of 980px.
- 3 Blueball Qubit v3 readme pdf files.
- 6 blank solid color banner image files to help create your own banner images with.

## **Adding Your Own Custom Banner Images Into The Qubit Design**

Your custom banner image is placed above the horizontal nav menu in the design layout under the Title and Tagline text, and under the Logo image.

**\*IMPORTANT - Your custom banner image must be sized exactly as noted below!**

**Qubit banner image size - 980px wide by 200px tall**

### **Logo Image**

The logo image is placed in the upper left area of the design layout in the #title div area to the left of the Title and Tagline lines of text over the banner image. **The logo image size is 200px wide by 128px tall. Your logo image file must be that exact size or it will not display correctly in the design layout.** Be sure it is set to a 72 ppi resolution and RGB color mode (sRGB is fine too) and saved as a jpg or png file. We recommend using the Save For Web feature in your image editor with quality settings between 55% to 80% saving it to a .jpg file format to keep the file size small.

### **Nav Menu Usage Tips - Important!**

**The horizontal nav menu layout used in the Blueball Qubit design allows you to have a normal amount of pages included in the top parent level and will wrap to 2 or more lines as needed in the main menu level.** The nav menu names will not wrap to 2 lines, so we highly recommend keeping your nav menus names as short as possible for the parent menu level. **Yes, there ARE hierarchical sub menu levels included with the Blueball Qubit designs starting in version 83 for Sandvox 2.**

### **Color Hexcodes Used In The Blueball Qubit Designs**

### **Title and Tagline Text Length**

**Title Text** - You must keep the Title text limited to one line of copy with any of the Blueball Qubit designs if the Tagline line of text is displayed. If the Tagline text is hidden, you can use 2 lines of Title text.

**Tagline Text** - We recommend only using 1 to 2 lines of Tagline text with the Title text displayed, although you have room to use up to 3 lines of text if needed. With the Title text hidden, you can use up to 4 to 5 lines of text if needed, although we recommend using a maximum of 3 lines of Tagline text at most with the Title text hidden.

## Using Images With Sidebar Objects

When placing images into Sidebar Objects (Pagelets in Sandvox 1.6) and Callouts, the Qubit design will automatically resize your images to fit using the default sizing we have specified in the Qubit design's plist file. You do not need to resize your image files unless you want to in Sandvox 2. This will be done automatically for you.

## Using Images In Sandvox 2 and The Blueball Qubit Designs

### **Your Site Page Image Sizes Will Be Displayed The Full Width Of The Content Area By Default If Wider Than The Content Area Width.**

We have increased the default image sizing for the content area to better utilize the available content area widths in the Blueball Qubit designs. In other words, the widths are set to fill up the available content area width (less 15px) by default with the sidebar showing instead of being restricted to just the Sandvox default image 320px width. Once you place your image into your page layout, you can resize it as needed in Sandvox 2 by selecting the image and dragging the handles to reduce or enlarge it's size.

### **We've Arranged Our main.css File Code Into Groups For Easier Modification By Advanced Sandvox Users**

If you open the main.css file you will see that the css code in our file is arranged in groups by areas of the design layout. We designed it this way to make it easier for advanced Sandvox users who want to "tinker under the hood" and customize the css some.

### **BE SURE TO MAKE A BACKUP COPY OF YOUR DESIGN BEFORE ATTEMPTING ANY MODIFICATIONS OF THE CSS CODE!**

**\*NOTE!!! We do not recommend modifying the css code in this design unless you are well versed and familiar with css styling and coding.** Modifying the css code could break the display functionality of the design in your Sandvox site. **Any modifications are at the sole risk of the user and Blueball Design does not guarantee the performance of any Blueball Sandvox Design which has been altered or modified and we cannot be held liable if problems arise from your modifications.**
